## **Small Group Discussion Questions**

## **HEAD**

What was the main point (i.e., big idea) of the sermon?

What questions did this sermon raise for you?

## **HANDS**

What are the <u>personal implications</u> (hands) of the message for your life?

What changes need to occur with regard to specific personal actions, attitudes, and behaviors?

Note: The above two questions focus on individual implications. But our obedience is more than something that's personal; our obedience (or lack thereof) impacts the entire body so...

What are the <u>communal implications</u> (gospel community) of the message? How should this passage shape the way we relate to one another specifically?

What are the <u>missional implications</u> of the message? How should this text impact the way you relate to others (especially outside the church), in light of the gospel?

## **HEART**

How should the gospel shape my motives (heart) in response to this message?

- Where is my hope, in light of the gospel, in view of this text (i.e., how does the gospel liberate me towards obedience)?
- What fears does this passage help me overcome, in light of the gospel?
- How can I love others better in view of this text, in light of the gospel?

Were there any <u>other ways</u> not mentioned that the Holy Spirit spoke to you specifically through this passage of Scripture?

You can ask the same questions of any text and still find you way back to the gospel and how it impacts and shapes us.
